Walk 03 Wrockwardine

Distance 3.3 miles (but see below)

The full walk crosses fields, stiles, and a railway line and is unsuitable for wheelchair or pushchair users.

For all Walks: Exit the village hall car park turning left and follow the road keeping the church on your right passing the old school and schoolmasters house on your left, now a private residence.

At the junction turn right keeping the church on your right, continue to pass the 'Old Vicarage' on your left, take a look at the ground floor windows, possibly a throwback to the days of the Window Tax.

At the junction with a triangle of grass at its centre continue ahead in the same direction to pass the war memorial on your left heading downhill.

If you are doing either of the short walks, turn left here, passing in front of the 'Old Smithy'. Note what appears to be an old Anderson air raid shelter in the grass bank in front of the Smithy.

For the wheelchair walk, continue ahead and after 110m, take the lane on your left. Continue up this lane to the T-junction. Turn left to pass between the 20 mph road signs to rejoin the main walk at point (B).

For the alternate short walk, continue ahead passing the lane on your left to just beyond the 30 mph road signs and turn left up a grassy bank to pass through a kissing gate to rejoin the main walk at point (A).

For the main walk, continue straight downhill, then shortly after passing the 'Old Smithy' and before reaching the 30 mph road signs turn left up steps in the grassy bank to reach a stile. Cross stile and enter a field. Keeping to the left-hand side of a wooden telegraph pole cross the field to a double stile in the hedge opposite.

TCW – 03 – Wrockwardine and Allscott

Cross the double stile and enter a large field. Cross the field to its far-left hand corner. There is often a clear obvious path through this field, if not turn left over the stile and follow the edge of the field.

On reaching the gate in left hand corner of the field, turn left on the road. **Take extreme care along this short section of road.** Pass under the railway bridge and turn immediately right onto Back Lane.

Follow the lane through the village of Allscott for 630 metres to reach a T junction with Rushmoor Lane.

Turn left onto Rushmoor Lane and continue walking along the road for 300 metres to the T-junction with the B4394 at the 'Plough Inn'.

Cross the road with care to the footpath sign opposite. Follow the footpath as it passes the primary school on your left-hand side for approximately 200 metres to reach a foot crossing over the railway lines. **Take extreme care when crossing the railway line. Look and listen for approaching trains, observe Network Rail instructions and advice shown at crossing.**

Cross the railway and use the stile opposite to enter a field, crossing a wooden sleeper bridge. Cross the field heading towards a large lone oak tree with a view of the Wrekin Hill behind it. Pass the tree, continuing ahead towards the right-hand corner of a hedgerow.

Upon reaching the hedgerow continue ahead for 90 metres keeping the fence on your right-hand side. Where the wooden fencing ends turn right up a small bank and cross a wooden sleeper bridge (if you reach the corner of the hedgerow where it turns sharp right you have gone a bit too far, retrace your steps for 10 metres).

After 30 metres the path turns left through what was a wooden kissing gate. Follow the path for 100 metres to cross a stile and reach a road. Turn left and follow the road for 820 metres.

Just before the 'Wrockwardine' sign turn right up a short bank to reach and pass through a kissing gate to enter a field.

(Point A) If you are doing the short walk, you rejoin the main walk here.

Cross the field keeping the hedge on your left-hand side. In approximately 300 metres pass through a metal kissing gate alongside a field gate. Cross the next field to exit through another kissing gate in the right-hand corner to reach a road.

Turn left and follow the road. At the junction with a road to the right continue ahead to pass between the two 20 mph speed signs.

(Point B) If you are doing the wheelchair walk, you rejoin the main walk here, turning left

Continue along this road to reach a T junction on a bend.

At the junction turn left and continue along the road for 320 metres passing the cemetery on your left. Follow the road as it bears left, passing the junctions to your right and the 'Cludde Alms-Houses' on your left.

Follow the road towards the church, passing the Old Shop and Schoolhouse on your left.

At the junction in front of the church turn right to return to the Village Hall car park and the end of the walk.
